



***FIRST* Scholarship**

Scholarship Description

In support of the *FIRST* mission, Tulane University is offering a merit-based scholarship for \$24,000, to a high school senior who has participated on a *FIRST* team during their junior or senior year. This scholarship may be utilized for any undergraduate course of study in the School of Science and Engineering at Tulane University. The scholarship is renewable up to a total of \$96,000 over four years, contingent upon maintaining good academic standing. Each recipient must meet the regular academic requirements for admission to Tulane University.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated at least one full season during your junior or senior year on a *FIRST* Robotics Competition (FRC) team or a *FIRST* Tech Challenge (FTC) team
- Apply and be admitted to Tulane University as a full time student. (However, you do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.)

Scholarship Application Package Contents

To apply for the Tulane University *FIRST* Scholarship, complete the application package, including:

- A completed Tulane University *FIRST* Scholarship Application
- A letter of recommendation from an adult mentor/coach on your *FIRST* team
