The Mayoral Scholarship Program provides a full-tuition, four-year scholarship to Tulane University for New Orleans residents who are graduates of New Orleans high schools and who meet the eligibility criteria below. Students interested in applying for a Mayoral Scholarship must complete this form and return it to the Office of Undergraduate Admission, via mail (210 Gibson Hall, Tulane University, New Orleans, LA 70118-5680) or fax (504.862.8715) by January 15.

Eligibility:

Any student who is a graduate of a high school located in Orleans Parish and who is a resident of, and legally domiciled in, Orleans Parish may apply for the Mayoral Scholarship. Applicants meeting the following criteria, and who are admitted to a full-time Undergraduate division of Tulane University, shall be eligible to compete for the scholarship:

- 1) Demonstrate academic performance (based on grades, quality and difficulty of high school course work and standardized test scores)
- 2) Demonstrate financial need according to federal guidelines (results of the FAFSA (<http://fafsa.ed.gov>) and CSS Profile (<https://profileonline.collegeboard.com>) financial aid forms
- 3) Demonstrate leadership in and participate in extracurricular activities or community service
- 4) Submit a letter of recommendation from a high school guidance counselor, principal, or headmaster

Deadlines:

Candidates for the Mayoral Scholarships must submit this form and an application for full-time undergraduate admission to Tulane University by January 15. In addition, applicants must file the CSS Profile and FAFSA financial aid forms with the College Scholarship Service and the federal processor respectively by February 15. Late or incomplete applications cannot be considered.

Notification:

The Mayor will announce the winners of the Mayoral Scholarships by April 15. Winners must notify Tulane University of admission and scholarship acceptance by May 1 by submitting the appropriate enrollment forms and deposit.

Disclosure Requirement:

No person related to an elected official* (i.e., child, brother, sister, parent, spouse, aunt, uncle, nephew, niece, first cousin, mother-in-law, father-in-law, sister-in-law or brother-in-law) shall be eligible to receive a Mayoral Scholarship unless the relationship of the recipient is hereby disclosed and the recipient is certified by Tulane University as having ranked among the eligible applicants with the highest academic credentials and highest level of financial need under Federal guidelines established for financial need.

* Elected officials include persons elected to public office in the state of Louisiana, including U.S. Senators and Representatives, state elected officials (including members of the legislature), state, municipal and parish officials, and persons elected to serve on political party committees.
